The secretary along with the members and the student members will be having a short meeting to discuss on the topic that had been allotted for the month.


These meetings of the club, every month would enable them to build up relationship with the members of the club.

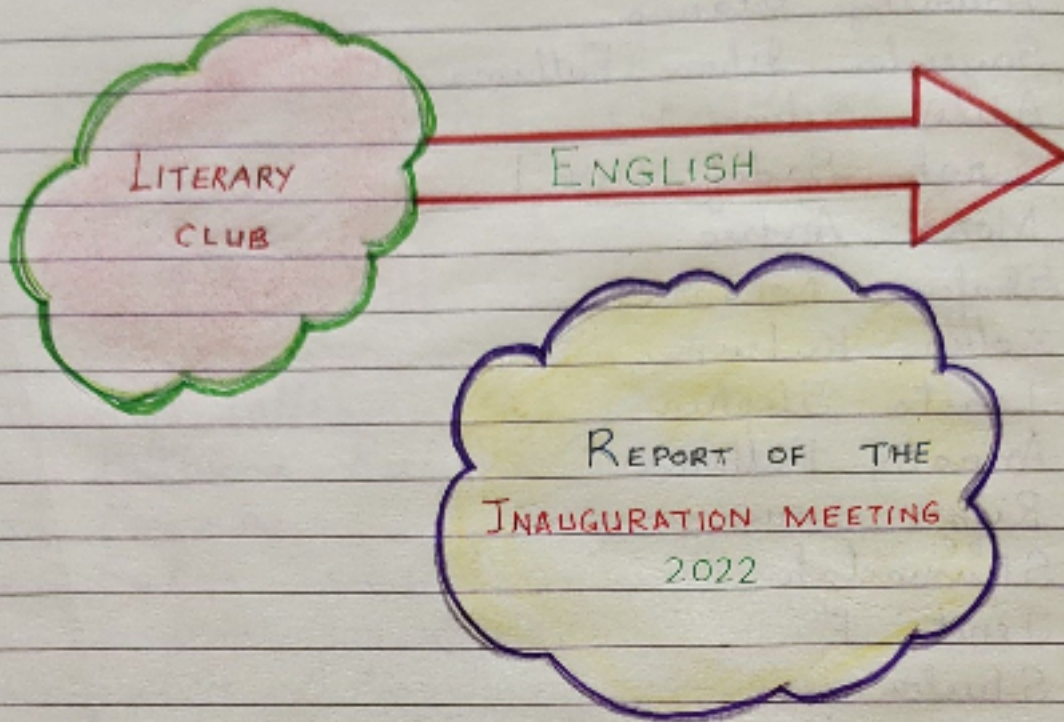

REPORT OF THE MEETING

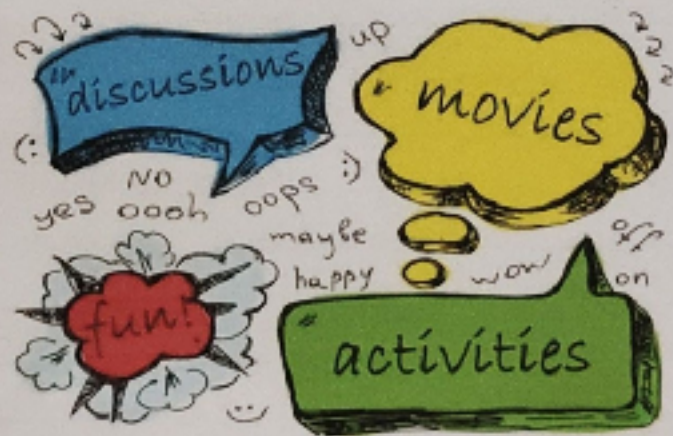
The second gathering of the "Literary Club" was organised on 15th October 2022.

The main goal behind to-day's gathering was to encourage the students to be bold to face the gathering as well deliver their speech without fear.

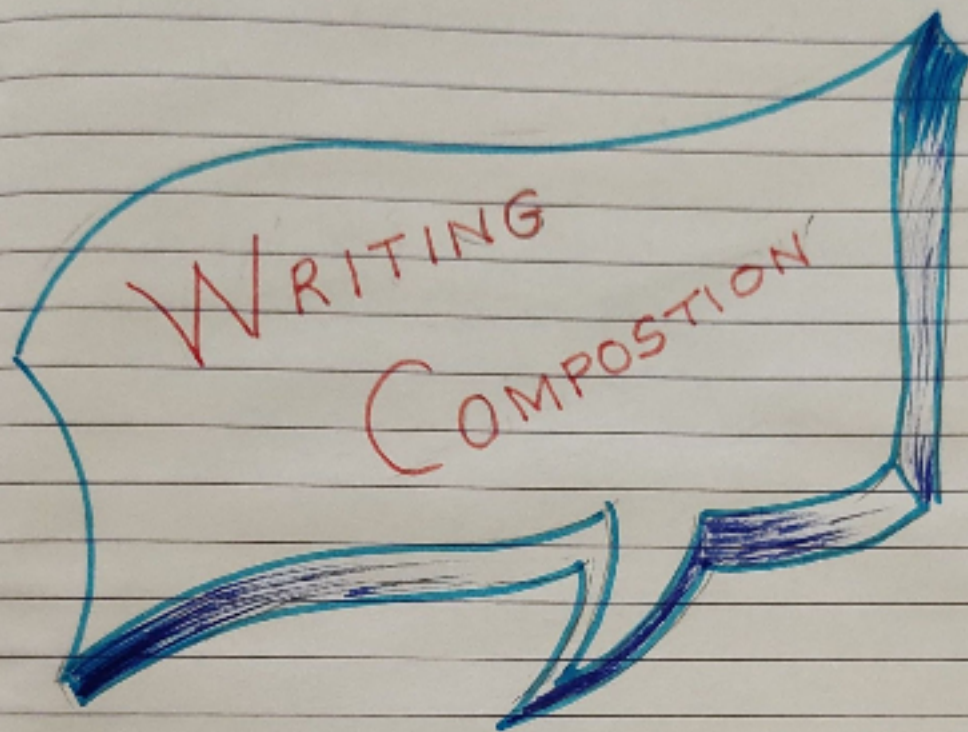
The session was interesting, encouraging, motivating and an enjoyable one.
